RE: Unauthorized use – Labor Law Posters

To Whom It May Concern:

North Carolina General Statute § 95-9 requires all employers in North Carolina who employ five or more persons to post a printed notice in the workplace “stating the provisions of the law relative to the employment of adult persons and children and the regulation of hours and working conditions.” The North Carolina Department of Labor (NCDOL) provides labor law posters that satisfy this requirement upon request free of charge. NCDOL is the proprietor of all copyright in these posters as of September 1, 2015.

It has come to our attention that your company may be using and selling posters that are identical/substantially similar to the NCDOL’s labor law poster. Unauthorized use and/or sale of the NCDOL Wage & Hour Notice to Employees poster and the OSH Notice to Employees poster constitutes copyright infringement under US copyright law (17 U.S.C. § 501). Please note that copyright legislation provides for strict liability, meaning that you can be found liable for infringement regardless of your level of knowledge of the infringement or your intent. 
