Persons who believe they have been denied equal opportunity may file a complaint with the *Nevada Equal Rights Commission*.

The Nevada Equal Rights Commission works in cooperation with the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, and U.S. Department of Justice in the administration and referral of complaints regarding discrimination in employment, housing, and public accommodations.
