

Illinois' New Minimum Wage

\$7.50 per hour

July 1, 2007 - June 30, 2008

- The minimum wage will increase by another 25 cents each July 1st for the next three years (in 2008, 2009, and 2010).
- New employees (first 90 days of employment) and employees under age 18 may be paid up to 50 cents less per hour.
- Tipped employees may be paid 60% of the hourly minimum wage (\$4.50 through June 30, 2008).
- Certain employees must be paid overtime, at time and one-half of the regular rate, after 40 hours of work in a workweek.
