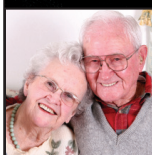

Nothing is more important than your health. Under Connecticut law you have rights in health insurance—it's important to know what they are. Coverage must include:

- Emergency treatment
- The right to appeal a decision made by your insurance company
- Preventive cancer screenings
- Mental health coverage
- Lyme disease treatment
- Diabetes care—among others
