



## CONGRATULATIONS



Every time I come across this photo I think..... "A Giant Lives There! Don't tell him Kyle sat in his chair."







## Memorable Family Vacation





One of my accomplishments in life was “how to make others happy” with the simple things of life. This began at an early age for me when I was asked to take a pie or loaf of bread to neighbors who lived poorly and had less than we.

All through my years of growing up in the Bishop family of 10, I learned to share and respect persons, regardless of name, color or race. being the middle child of 10 children, I learned to give and take. I learned from my parents how to pray, worship and thank God daily for all he gave us.

When I decided how I would make my mark in life, I heard a voice asking me to “Come Follow Me and I will show you the way”. The way to love serve and pray.

At an early age of eighteen years, I gave my life to God to serve his people through my religious vows. Forty years later, I can testify that through my vows and ministry of nursing, I have learned to respect all people and most of all have learned to trust in our Heavenly Father that he will show me through the opportunity of prayer what I must be all about, in continuing how to give of myself for others.

*Aunt Liz, known as Sister Elizabeth would like to share her story of life from being a young girl to now a professed Dominican sister for fifty years.*

It all began March 20<sup>th</sup> 1935. I came into this Bishop family, the sixth child of Alphonse and Mary Bishop. These loving parents, as well as three brothers and six sisters nurtured me. As for my childhood, I would say it was as normal as anyone else's, given the era in which I grew up. I came as a baby out of the Depression years. I remember the bombing of Pearl Harbor on December 7<sup>th</sup> 1941, the POW's (prisoners of war), and the WPA's (Works Progress Administration) who drove up and down our roads to work on our farmlands. At the time of the war, I remember standing in line many times for my mother, while she shopped, to use the stamps that were given to us to get one pair of nylons. Nylon was scarce because it was a product used for the war. We could stand in line for a couple of hours to get this one pair of nylons just to be told that when our turn came, they were all out. Also, we saved scrap iron and sold it. Can't remember why, but it was money for the family. We picked milk pods to send to the government to make vests for our men in the Navy. I remember my oldest sister getting the award because our family gathered the most milk pods in the area. She became the *Milk Pod Queen*.

About ten years later I saw my three brothers drafted into the Korean War, There were additional chores for my four younger sisters and me in their absence like milking the cows with the electric milker before the school day began. Yet, I would say that I experienced a happy childhood and typical teenage years. I was a cheerleader on the varsity squad for four years and I did date a young man by the name of Charles Garant. I had many girlfriends, one whom I still remain very close even though she lives in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Her name is Jeannette Weisenberger Butterfield. Along with these friends, I was allowed to attend school social functions and go to dances on Saturday nights, which was our main activity of the 50's.

I attended Maple Grove High School and was taught by the Dominican Sisters. You may ask why the school was called Maple Grove High. For some reason when I was around the 5<sup>th</sup> grade, our pastor, Fr. Bosler decided to run the school with state funded money and yet keep the Dominican Sisters to teach the students. Around the 8<sup>th</sup> grade I began thinking I would like to be a nun, just like the ones who were teaching us at the school. One of the sisters that I liked was Sister Judith Adams. It seemed the more I liked her the more she disliked me because I was "boy crazy" and had to be reminded to stop chasing the boys. She reported me to my parents several times who didn't think it was anything abnormal after raising five other teens. My parents were role models in teaching us the valued of life. I learned what it meant to share with nine siblings and to work hard whether it was at home or with my school studies. Prayer was a top priority in our family and each night we gathered as a family on bended knees with no excuse not to be there. I think sometimes we even prayed to saints who were not yet in heaven!

At the age of sixteen, I was allowed to date my first boyfriend, Charlie, who is now married and has had a successful married life. I dated Charlie for a while, then Bernie. I always had to double date because my parents believed this would keep one from getting into any kind of trouble. I felt my parents always trusted me and I took pride in pleasing them.

It was the latter part of my senior year, when serious questions came to mind as to what I

was going to do after my high school days. I tried to quiet the voices that God was calling me to Religious Life. I didn't want my friends to know that I was considering a commitment to it. And so I continued to dance the *Dance of Life* until nearly Graduation Day when I told my Mother "I think I am going to become a nun." She put her arms around me and said she would be proud to have a second daughter in religious life, as I already had an older sister, Rita, who had joined Religious Life five years earlier.

Now I had to tell my friends that I was going to the convent. They could not believe it was true because I enjoyed the fun of life and even talked about having a large family, just like the one I grew up in for the past eighteen years. I prayed to our Blessed Mother, who then seemed to be the role model for all Catholic girls. I could not quiet the voices of "Come Follow Me" and so I not only told the sisters in the parish and my friends, but also made a trip to Grand Rapids, Michigan to check things out with the Mother Victor, who was the prioress at the time. I thought maybe if she would think I was not an appropriate candidate and this would quiet the *Call*. Low and behold I received a letter a few weeks later telling me that I had been accepted and that I would need to bring underwear, socks, and black shoes with a \$60.00 dowry. The Sisters would provide the dress that I was to wear as a Postulant. Good timing, as my oldest brother, Eugene was returning from the Korean War and would resume the responsibilities on the farm.

On September 8<sup>th</sup>, 1953, I left my home for Marywood in Grand Rapids. My first year I was called a *Postulant* and during this year I attended Aquinas College with academic study for the full year. The following May I was given the Dominican Habit and took my first vows of Poverty, Chastity and Obedience. I was given a new name by the order that of Sister Alphonsine. During the next year we lived a more cloistered life and studied theology and courses on religious life. After my second year, I became a fully professed Dominican Sister and then made preparation to take summer classes at Aquinas for teaching as I had entered a teaching order. Instead I was asked by my superiors to consider becoming a nurse. Nursing was not something I even thought about, but because of my vow of obedience, I knew nursing was where God wanted me to serve Him in religious life. So I became that nurse and served in hospitals in New Mexico and Michigan. My experiences varied from Medical Surgery, Obstetrics, E.R., Recovery Room, Surgical Nursing, Visiting Nurse, and caring of the Mentally Ill. These experiences not only as a nurse, but also as a nun have made me who I am today. With a few challenges thrown in along the way, my life has been blessed with abundance of God's love for me. I have trusted in God with the gift of faith that was given to me at Baptism, that God who began a good work in me will see it through completion.

The words of Jeremiah 29: 11-14 say it all:

*For I know well the plans I have for you,  
Plans for your welfare, not for woe,  
Plans to give you a future full of hope when you call upon me,  
When you go to pray to me, I will listen to you.  
When you look for me, you will find me with all your heart.  
You will find me with you says the Lord and I will change your lot.*

After building and moving into their new home in July of 1999, Doug and Brenda had yet one more son, Samuel Henry, on March 27, 2000, to complete their family.







# Memorable Family Story

January 18, 1993

This is a very memorable family story and although it didn't happen very long ago, it will remain forever embedded in my mind as well as my heart.

It was December 4, 1992 when my husband of only 8 months boarded a United flight at the Detroit Metro Airport. He was leaving on military orders for Shemya, Alaska. He had been given notice of this tour in mid-September of the same year and had the option to take it or to turn it down. The tour would be a one year unaccompanied remote assignment. This military jargon meant that he would be gone 365 days without his spouse or any child of his if there were any.

If we turned down the assignment, we would continue out lives in Midwest City, Oklahoma as Leverette was stationed at Tinker Air Force Base. The only problem with staying here was that Leverette was in a high-mobility squadron and always on alert to go to where the military needed him. We knew that his name was at the top of the list for going on a 6 month tour to Honduras to assist the DEA with the over-the-border drug trafficking into the states. It was a very dangerous assignment.

With many things to consider, we thought that the only thing to do was accept the tour to Shemya. This meant that Leverette would serve his year on the 2 mile by 4 mile island while I stayed with my parents in Chesaning, Michigan until we found out where our "follow-on" assignment was.

The movers from Atlas came to our cute, homey apartment on November 11, 1992 and packed up our lives, or so I felt. Leverette had received word that our follow-on would be a three year tour in Anchorage, Alaska. What a ride our belongings would have, travelling along the Alaskan Pipe line.

We travelled home to Chesaning on November 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>, our cars packed to the ceiling with those things what we thought were too valuable to trust in the hands of total strangers (our movers). Although it rained non-stop on our trip home, we managed to make it there in good time. We spent two wonderful weeks together, sharing our married lives once again with our families.

So now at the Airport, we held each others hand so tightly, not wanting to let go but knowing that it would eventually happen. First call boarding came followed by second then the final call. Leverette looked into my eyes, holding my face in his hands and told me that he was sorry for having to do this. "I love you" followed.

Nobody will ever know what we were feeling. So many things would happen over the next year that we wouldn't be able to experience together. Our first Christmas as Mr. & Mrs. Leverette Hoover would have to be put off another year. As well as our first wedding anniversary in May (our cake would have to sit in my Mom and Dad's freezer for yet another year) postponed.

Although it's only been a month and a half, we're doing alright. Some days seem unbearable, but if anything, it's taught us to NOT take each other for granted. Once we're reunited, we're going to celebrate our love for each other and the chance to show each other everyday of our life.


